Policy Code of Behaviour – Spectators

Effective Date 15 January 2007

As a spectator in any activity held by or under the auspices of Riverstone Schofields Junior Soccer Football Club (the Club), you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during any such activity or event:

- Respect the decisions of officials and teach young people to do the same.
- ® Never ridicule or scold a young player for making a mistake. Positive comments are motivational.
- © Condemn the use of violence in any form, whether it is by other spectators, coaches, officials or players.
- Show respect for your team's opponents. Without them there would be no game.
- Show appreciation for good performance and skilful plays by all players (including opposing players).
- Do not use violence, harassment or abuse in any form (that is, do not use foul language, sledge or harass players, coaches, officials or other spectators).
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.

Any person failing to comply with this policy may be asked to leave the grounds and be subject to disciplinary action by the Club
