Policy Code of Behaviour – Players

In addition to Riverstone Schofields Junior Soccer Football Club's (the Club) General Code of Behaviour, you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during any activity held or sanctioned by the Club and in your role as a player/participant in any activity held by or under the auspices of the Club

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of fellow players, coaches, officials and spectators regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Do not tolerate acts of aggression.
- Do not use violence, harassment or abuse in any form (that is do not use foul language, sledge or harass players, coaches, officials or spectators).
- Respect the talent, potential and development of fellow players and competitors.
- Be frank and honest with your coach concerning illness and injury and your ability to train fully within the program requirements.
- At all times avoid intimate relationships with your coach.
- Conduct yourself in a professional manner relating to language, temper and punctuality.
- Maintain high personal behaviour standards at all times.
- Abide by the rules and respect the decision of the official, making all appeals through the formal process and respecting the final decision.
- Be honest in your attitude and preparation to training. Work equally hard for yourself and your team.
- Cooperate with coaches and staff in development of programs to adequately prepare you for competition at the highest level.
- Refrain from taking or using performance enhancing drugs, taking or using illegal substances, or consuming alcohol before during and after training sessions on the playing fields or surrounding areas
- Refrain from taking or using performance enhancing drugs, taking or using of illegal substances, or consuming alcohol before, during and after games representing the Club

Any player failing to comply with this policy may be subject to disciplinary action by the Club, including withdrawal of their registration with the Blacktown District Soccer Federation and/or cancellation of their membership of the Club.
