Policy Code of Behaviour – General

As a member of Riverstone Schofields Junior Soccer Football Club (the Club) or a person required to comply with the Club's Member Protection Policy, you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during any activity held or sanctioned by the Club and in any role you hold within the Club:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others.
- Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealing with others.
- Be professional in, and accept responsibility for, your actions.
- Be aware of, and maintain an uncompromising adhesion to Riverstone Schofields Junior Soccer Football Club Inc's standards, rules, regulations and policies.
- Toperate within the rules of soccer, including national and international guidelines which govern the Club.
- Do not use your involvement with the Club to promote your own beliefs, behaviours or practices where these are inconsistent with those of the Club.
- Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially when dealing with persons under 18 years of age, as your words and actions are an example.
- Avoid unaccompanied and unobserved activities with persons under 18 years of age, wherever possible.
- Refrain from any form of harassment of others.
- Refrain from any behaviour that may bring the Club into disrepute.
- Provide a safe environment for the conduct of soccer or any activity held or sanctioned by the Club.
- Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured.
- Be a positive role model.
- Understand the repercussions if you breach, or are aware of any breaches of, this code of behaviour.

Any person failing to comply with this policy may be asked to leave the grounds and be subject to disciplinary action by the Club
